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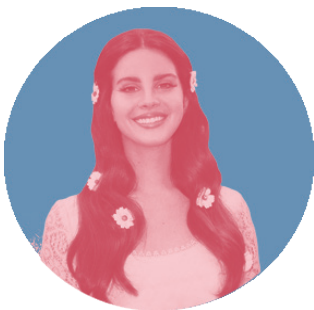
How to Win an Argument on Stan Twitter

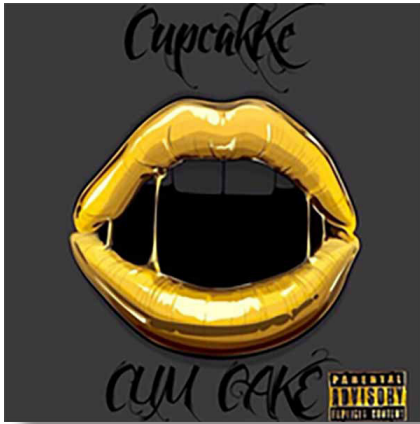
“Several Isolated Whinnies - Version 1” by Sound Ideas

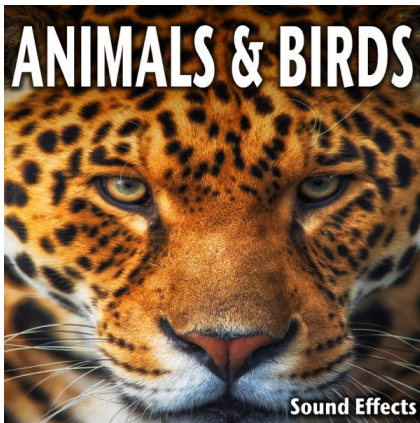
“Recorder Freestyle” by Timotainment

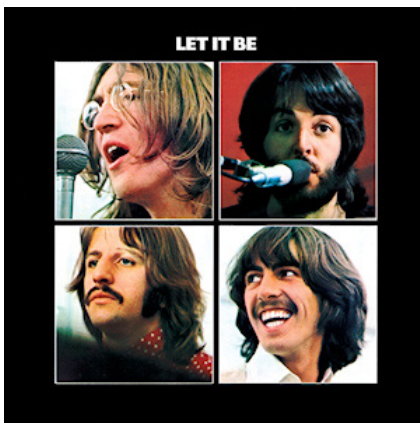
“Deep Throat” by Cupkkake

“Let it Be” by The Beatles

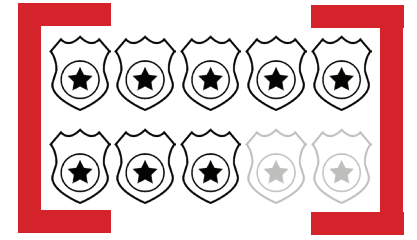
I can only assume at this point that the goal is to ruin the Beatles by including them on this playlist and making you associate this song with the feeling of eating cold tofu scramble.

Herschel Walker Drops an Album



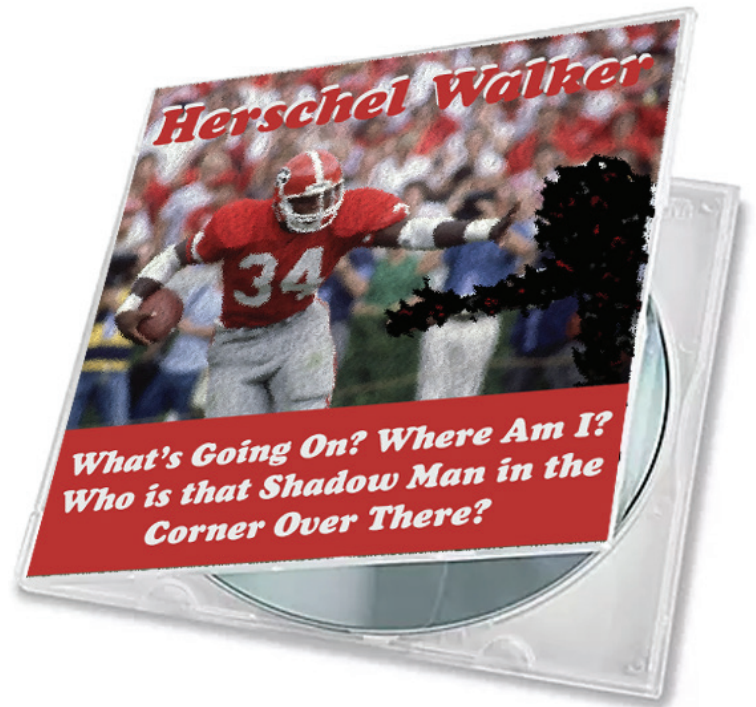

Will you join me in the fight against Big Recorder? Be careful what you say, it might be recorded.

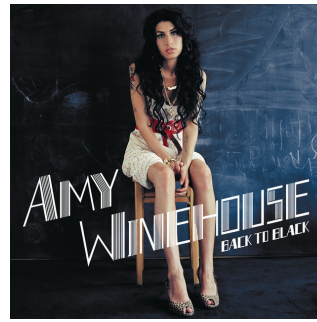


GLEE CAST COVERS THAT EMBARASS THE ORIGINAL VERSIONS

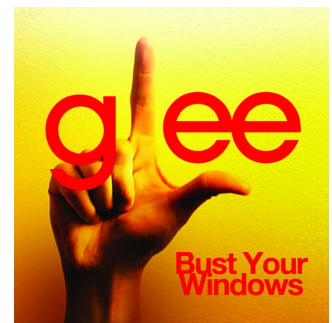

In this very special edition of *Rolling Bone*, we are proud to present a list of *Glee* covers that are indisputably and unconditionally better than the original versions.



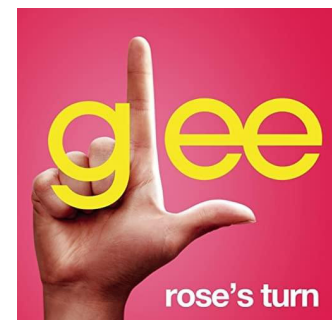
“VALERIE” BY AMY WINEHOUSE, SUNG BY SANTANA

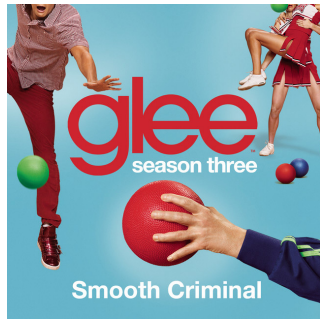
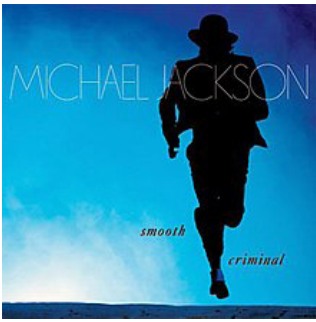
“BUST YOUR WINDOWS” BY JAZMINE SULLIVAN, SUNG BY MERCEDES

Most Mercedes solos go harder than the original, but this anthem was given to us in only the third episode of the entire series. Diabolical.



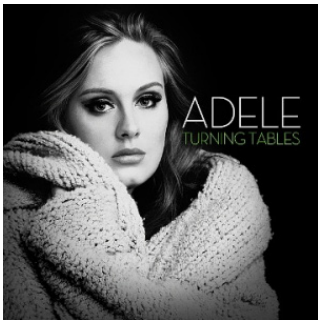
“ROSE’S TURN” BY BETTE MIDDLE, SUNG BY KURT
